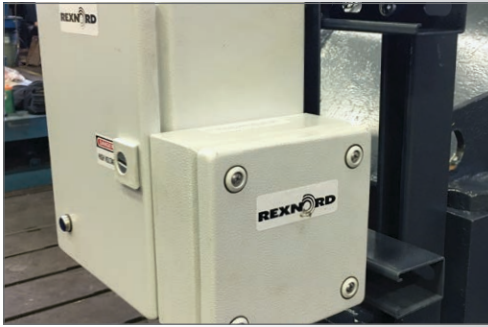
What does the Training Program include?

Registration Process

Sessions run from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm daily.

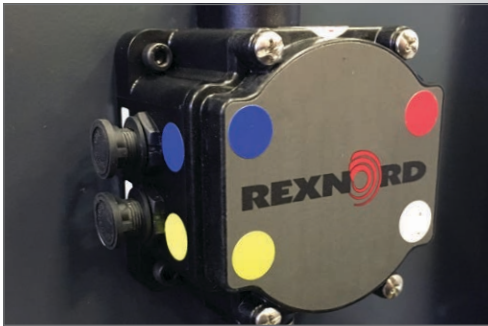


Supplies & Equipment

We provide all tools, equipment and supplies. You will be working in a shop setting every day with heavy equipment. Dress casually but appropriately for personal safety. Eye protection is required and will be provided. Bring steel toe safety shoes. Canvas or soft-soled shoes will not be permitted.

Hotel & Accommodations

Attendees will be asked to make their own hotel reservations. Rexnord will provide recommended hotel accommodations for non-local attendees along with the Rexnord rate of an estimated \$100/night. Each attendee will be responsible for transportation to and from class, as well as evening meals. Lunch will be provided each day at the training facility.



Class Size
